



## Over the Edge Fundraising Ideas

- Ask for one Christmas gift to be given as a donation for Over the Edge!
- If you have a birthday between now and the event, ask for one gift as a donation for Over the Edge!
- Do a yard sale and make an easy \$100+ in one day!
- 500 Raffle Challenge—
  - The idea is simple: you go out and purchase a specific raffle item that your colleagues will want. From that, you create a raffle of up to 500 chances to win this raffle prize in a unique way.
  - Here's how it works:
    1. Secure a nice raffle item that others will want.
    2. Create 2 poster boards and draw 1-250 small square boxes on one poster and 251-500 on the other poster board.
    3. Get a roll of raffle tickets and number them 1-500.
    4. Put the tickets in a bucket and mix them up.
    5. Let everyone in your workplace know about the raffle prize.
    6. However much someone donates, that's the number of raffle tickets or poker chips they will receive.
      - If they draw Raffle Ticket #1 = \$0.01
      - If they draw Raffle Ticket #2 = \$0.02
      - *(And so on and so forth)*
      - If they draw Raffle Ticket #499 = \$4.99
      - If they draw Raffle Ticket #500 = \$5.00
      - For example:
        - If someone puts a \$10 bill into the raffle, they would draw out however many raffle tickets until it equals \$10. (see above)
        - If someone puts in \$20 into the raffle, they would draw out however many raffle tickets until it equals \$20 (see above)
    7. Then, you simply write their name on each square on the poster board.
      - For example:
        - If you had someone who had drawn raffle tickets #3, #33, #499, you would write his/her name on each of the squares on the board.
    8. Lastly, once the squares are filled up, you randomly select from the copies of the raffle tickets the winner!
    9. If you fill up all 500 squares, you will raise \$1,200+ regardless!
