

Unified Gardening Grant Fact Sheet

To submit for the Unified Gardening Grant:

- Complete the [Unified Gardening Grant Application](https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/UnifiedGardeningGrant) by December 31st, 2017 (online at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/UnifiedGardeningGrant>).
- We will review all submissions and announce Unified Garden Grant Recipients the first week of January 2018.

Timeline:

- 1st week of January 2018 – Winners of Unified Gardening Grant Recipients announced
- January 2018 – Implementation of Unified Garden begins
- February 2018 – Brief update to SOAZ sharing progress of Unified Garden and include a photo
- March 2018 – Final update to SOAZ
 - Short paragraph or two on what your garden is and how it was inclusive
 - How many participants with and without intellectual disabilities did you engage? (Please be sure to provide two separate numbers)
 - How often did you work on the garden?
 - How has it impacted your Unified Champion School or community delegation?
 - How did you spend your \$100 seed money?
 - What additional support would you need to help grow your garden? (i.e. tools, seeds, community plot, etc)
 - April 2018 – Unified Gardening Carrot Competition
 - May 2018 – Winners of Unified Gardening Carrot Competition announced



Terms of the Unified Gardening Grant:

- You will receive monthly updates from UnifiedClubs@SpecialOlympicsArizona.org sharing tips of crops to grow, proper care, community classes available, and ideas for healthy recipes with your growing crops!
- You will need to report on your Unified Garden twice (February 2018 and March 2018) and include photos
- All gardens can grow any vegetables you would like and must include carrots for the Carrot Competition in April 2018
- You will need to display your Unified Garden at a local area competition in April 2018. You will receive information in December on what to bring, what to display, photos to take and where to send them, and where to display your Unified Garden. You will need to ensure you display your carrot(s) for the Carrot Competition
